



California's Ergonomics Law: Metalworking Workshop and Training

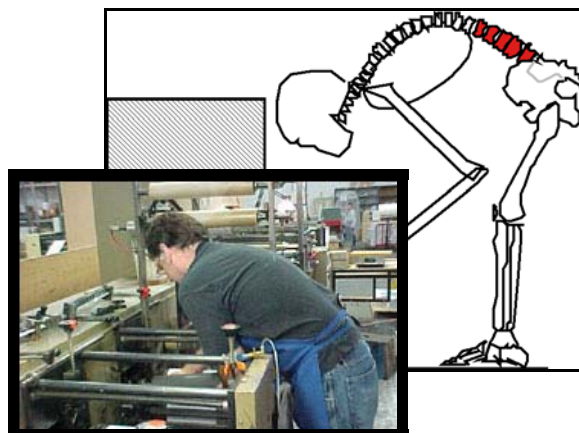

Title 8– Section 5110 of the California Code of Regulations is the standard for Repetitive Motion Injuries (RMI's). Also known as ergonomics, this state law is enforceable against metalworking companies of every size.
