The CMC roundtables bring California's elected officials to you. There are only 40 state Senators casting votes in Sacramento. On July 24, state **Senator Alan Lowenthal (D-27)** will meet our group and hear our issues during the last hour of the session. District 27 encompasses Paramount, Bellflower, Downey, Lakewood, Lynwood, and parts of Long Beach (including the port) and South Gate.

Senator Lowenthal spent 6 years in the state Assembly, and is the leading Democrat voice on redistricting reform. He also sits on the Senate Environmental Quality, and Transportation committees. **CMC supporters will exchange information with a real Sacramento decision maker. We'll see you on July 24 in Downey!**
