



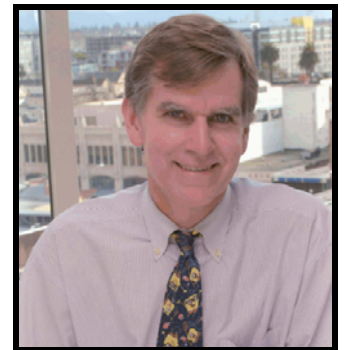
CMC REGIONAL ROUNDTABLE
