*JANUARY 1, 2010 IS APPROACHING
MAKE SURE YOU'RE READY TODAY!*

Assembly Bill 1953 (Chan-D) was signed into law in 2006 and will take effect January 1, 2010. The bill impacts all products intended to convey or dispense water for human consumption by lowering the lead content limit (wetted surface) to 0.25%.

Some **metalworking facilities** are ready for this change. Others across the United States—and possibly the world—are testing alloys and preparing for changes in their product lines.

Some California **water utilities and government agencies** are aware of the new law. But several others have not yet been properly educated on how AB 1953 will impact them.

This conference will bring together the various groups of stakeholders impacted by this new law. Good information is the key to making effective decisions.

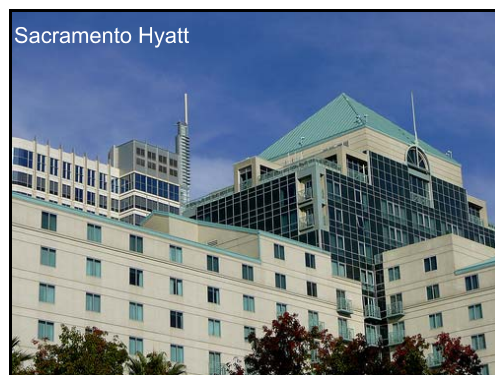
