The California Metals Coalition (CMC) has once again teamed-up with the Precision Metalforming Association (PMA) California District to bring a timely, important meeting to California's metalworking industry.

There is a perception among many businesses that research and development credits (R&D) are given only to people dressed in white jumpsuits working in expensive labs. Many are surprised to learn that even if their metalworking business does little or no conventional R&D, they may still qualify for tax credits. In fact, just running your business the way you have been for years might qualify your company for \$100,000 or more in tax credits!

The key is understanding this special area of tax. This is where *Black Line Group*, an R&D tax credit firm, comes in.
