Mayor Wilson is the **Republican nominee for the 15th Assembly District**—which includes Livermore, San Ramon, Walnut Creek and Danville. The 15th Assembly district is **arguably the most contested Assembly race** in the November election. The seat is currently held by a Republican, but it is being targeted by Democrat fundraisers and supporters.

Abram Wilson was elected to city council in 1999 and elected Mayor of San Ramon in 2003. There are only 80 votes in the state Assembly. Protecting this Republican seat is critical for our interests. **CMC supporters will exchange information with a real decision maker.** *We'll see you on September 30!*
