Dr. Raymond Sfeir, Chief Economist, Chapman University

- California's leading voice on the state's manufacturing performance and economics is Dr. Raymond Sfeir, Director, Chapman University Anderson Center for Economic Research. Dr. Sfeir's research includes capital asset pricing models, operations research, and applied economics. He is frequently in The Los Angeles Times and Orange County Register. Dr. Sfeir also conducts the California quarterly survey of purchasing managers and manufacturing sentiment.



Jim Brulte, Chairman, California Republican Party (invited)

- Jim Brulte is the chairman of the California Republican Party, since March 3, 2013. Brulte formerly served in the California State Senate, representing the 31st district, from 1996 to 2004. He also served as the Senate Republican leader from 2000 to 2004. He was previously the Republican Leader of the California State Assembly from 1992 to 1996. Brulte is the only freshman to ever serve as a party leader in both houses of the California State Legislature.



State Senator Connie Leyva (D-Chino) (invited)

- Senator Connie Leyva (D) is 1 of 40 state Senators serving in the California Legislature. She was elected in 2014 to represent the 20th State Senate District, which includes the cities and communities of Bloomington, Chino, Colton, Fontana, Grand Terrace, Montclair, Muscoy, Ontario, Pomona, Rialto and San Bernardino. She has authored legislation into law that impacts Career Technical Education (CTE) and removing lead from public utility pipes.



Topic: Anticipated Metal Grinding, PM, Dust and Odor Regulations

- The wave of new metal grinding regulations is hitting all sectors of California's metalworking industry. CMC is dedicating 2.5 hours of the agenda to tackling the expected requirements. This includes total facility enclosures, baghouse and secondary controls, source testing, housekeeping, and more. Speakers include: Ramboll Environ, Keramida, Air Cleaning Systems, Baghouse Services, Total Clean, and Castellon and Funderburk Law Firm.



Topic: Sales Tax Exemptions for Equipment and Tooling & New R&D Tax Credit Opportunities
