Support AB 427 (Muratsuchi) California Aerospace Commission

The organizations listed below **SUPPORT AB 427**, as amended January 11, 2018, that establishes the California Aerospace and Aviation Commission to support the health and competitiveness of California's landmark aerospace manufacturing sector.

The aerospace industry represents a broad sector of manufacturers and R&D companies that cover a large geographical area in California from San Diego and the High Desert to the greater Los Angeles/Orange County area and Silicon Valley. California aerospace employment totals over 200,000 jobs according to a 2014 report from ATKearney for the Los Angeles Economic Development Corporation and with the continued reshoring of manufacturing jobs, California represents an opportunity to create new jobs and help rebuild the middle class.

California recognizes the importance of key economic sectors, such as the motion picture industry, and has created commissions of public and private sector representatives to evaluate current policy and make recommendations for changes that promote further development of the industry. The state has long benefited from the economic strength of the aerospace sector and should now create this commission to support the continued vitality and innovation of the industry.
