<u>ABOUT:</u> New requirements for California's storm water Industrial General Permit (IGP) take effect July 1, 2020. This webinar will cover Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDL) applicability, Mandatory Minimum Penalties (MMP), and options for a Time Scheduled Order (TSO).

All metal companies in California are subject to the storm water IGP. Depending on your proximity to an impaired water body, you may also be subject to TMDLs. This webinar will feature California storm water experts with experience in the metals sector (SIC 33xx, 34xx and 5193). Sign up today!

<u>TSO:</u> The Time Scheduled Order (TSO) must be submitted well in advance of July 1, 2020, and can extend the TMDL compliance date up to 5 years.

TMDL Examples: Listed in Attachment E, Table E-2 of the IGP, here are some examples of TMDLs that will impact metal companies: Los Angeles River, Los Cerritos Channel, San Diego Creek and Newport Bay, Rio Hondo River and Compton Creek.
