## **Background**

AB 617 requires specified stationary sources to report their annual emissions of criteria pollutants and toxic air contaminants to the California Air Resources Board (CARB). AB 617 also requires CARB to establish a uniform statewide system of annual reporting for the emissions data.

To implement these requirements, CARB is developing a proposed regulation for annual reporting of criteria pollutant and toxic air contaminant emissions for stationary sources (the Criteria and Toxics Emissions Reporting Regulation, or CTR). The proposed regulation will support the Community Air Protection Program, established as directed in Assembly Bill (AB) 617 (C.Garcia, Chapter 136, Statutes of 2017). The proposed regulation will also support other programs at CARB such as the AB 2588 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" program, State Implementation Plans, Air Toxic Control Measures, monitoring studies, and other Board activities.
